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## About Canada Bereavement Registry

The Canada Bereavement Registry is a free consumer service that helps put a stop to unwanted direct mail/phone calls for the deceased and assists in life insurance and pension checks for the bereaved.

Everyone receives direct mail and phone calls from organizations selling their products and services or for fundraising purposes. Unless these organizations are informed that a customer, donor, or prospect on their database has died, they will continue to contact that person, creating distress for the loved ones that receive the correspondence.

Estates can take time to settle and sometimes benefits relating to the deceased are unknown. We work with life insurance and pension companies to help find and sometimes expedite settlements and survivor pensions.

## Question & Answers

### Will this information be used for any other purpose?

The primary purpose of the information we collect is to stop direct marketing and phone calls to the deceased. The deceased's details are also used in other ways to benefit the bereaved such as identifying life insurance policies and pensions.

### Is there a cost for this?

No. This is a free service to the bereaved. Our income is derived from the companies that use this information to update contact lists and perform searches.

### Do you need the date of birth?

Although not mandatory, the date of birth is helpful to accurately match the name and address of the deceased. In some cases, it is possible to have a person with the same name in the same town, but it is unlikely that they share the same date of birth.

### Do you need the phone number?

Receiving a phone call for the deceased can be more upsetting than receiving a letter. Although not essential, the phone number is used as an additional reference to stop telemarketers phoning in the first place.

### How long does it take?

You should start to notice a reduction in mail and/or phone calls in about 6 weeks.

### What if the mail/calls do not stop?

If you continue to receive letters or marketing calls for the deceased, then please collect the details/items, put them in an envelope, and send them to us at our address located on the contact page. Alternatively, you can take photographs of the items and send them to us at [info@canada-bereavement-registry.ca](mailto:info@canada-bereavement-registry.ca) In both cases we will contact the organizations on your behalf, and free of charge, to ensure the deceased's details are removed from the marketing and mailings lists.

### How does the life insurance and pension benefits check work?

We work with life insurance and pension companies and if the deceased is associated with these organisations, then the life insurer or the pension plan will contact the beneficiary directly to discuss the process.
